DUE TO COVID-19 COUNTY ELECTION BOARD ENCOURGING ABSENTEE VOTING

On Tuesday, June 30th Oklahomans will head to the polls to conduct our State and County Primaries and local School Board elections.

The COVID-19 pandemic has had, and will continue to have a significant effect on our elections, and while we are taking every step necessary to conduct our in-person voting according to strict CDC guidelines, we are strongly urging Tulsa County voters to vote absentee by mail. This is especially important for our voters who are at a higher health and age risk during the crisis.

Because we are implementing strict CDC protocols at all our in-person voting locations we anticipate wait times to be longer than usual, which can be difficult for everyone but especially for our more vulnerable population.

Voting absentee by mail can be a much safer alternative for everyone and it is easy to apply.
