When an application is filed, official public notice is provided, and nearby residents and neighborhood associations are informed. The Board reviews appropriate plans and development policies to formulate a case study and analysis.

An action summary and/or minutes are prepared after each meeting and sent to various County policy and administrative officials for their information and/or action as appropriate.

The Board meets the third Tuesday of every month at 1:30 p.m. at the Saint Francis Health System Room, Williams Center Tower I, 1 W. 3<sup>rd</sup> St. (unless otherwise specified).
