RE: NOTICE OF HUD PROGRAM  
PUBLIC HEARINGS

DATE: February 13, 2019

The Department of Housing and Urban Development requires direct grantees of HUD funding to prepare a Consolidated Annual Action plan which examines housing and community development needs in the region and sets priorities for how the allocation of funds from HUD will be spent over the funding period. Although the Federal government has not yet given us a firm indication of the budget numbers for formula grant allocations for next year, it is time to begin the planning process for next year. Based on information from several community development and housing professional organizations, we have projected that the County will receive an allocation approximately equal to last year's allocation. It is anticipated, therefore, that Tulsa County would receive \$1,089,274 in FY2019 HOME funds and \$1,364,368 in FY2019 CDBG funds for the program year beginning July 1, 2019.

Per Tulsa County's adopted Citizen Participation Plan for the HOME Consortium and the CDBG Urban County, a public hearing to receive recommendations on housing needs for the cities and counties within the Metropolitan Tulsa HOME Consortium and non-housing community development needs for the cities within the Tulsa County CDBG Urban County is required prior to the submission of the Consolidated Annual Action Plan.

Comments and recommendations received will be considered by INCOG, the CDBG Urban County Policy Committee, and the Tulsa County Board of Commissioners in developing the Consolidated Annual Action Plan to be submitted to HUD. Comments or proposals, where feasible, will be incorporated into the Plan to be submitted to HUD by May 15, 2019.

We request that the Commissioners schedule a Public Hearing for Monday, March 11, 2019 at 9:30 a.m., and authorize advertisement of the Hearing in the Tulsa World.

Tulsa County anticipates receiving approximately \$1,089,274 in FY 2019 HOME funds and approximately \$1,364,368 in FY 2019 CDBG funds from the Department of Housing and Urban Development. Citizens are requested to participate in the Hearing and express their views on the allocation of these funds. Citizens are requested to express their views on housing needs in Bartlesville, Broken Arrow, Bixby, Bristow, Catoosa, Claremore, Collinsville, Coweta, Drumright, Glenpool, Hominy, Jenks, Owasso, Pawhuska, Sand Springs, Sapulpa, Skiatook, Sperry and the unincorporated areas of Creek, Osage, Rogers, Tulsa, Wagoner and Washington Counties. Citizens are also requested to express their views on non-housing community development needs in Broken Arrow, Bixby, Collinsville, Glenpool, Jenks, Owasso, Sand Springs, Sapulpa, Skiatook, Sperry, and the unincorporated areas of Tulsa County.

Recommendations received will be considered by INCOG, CDBG Urban County Policy Committee, and the Tulsa County Board of Commissioners in developing the Consolidated Annual Action Plan to be submitted to HUD. Comments or proposals, where feasible, will be incorporated into the Plan to be submitted to HUD by May 15, 2019.
