**EPA's New Risk Management Program regulations**

- Tom Bergman with Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (ODEQ) presented a new regulation passed on December 21, 2016 for RMP facilities under the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act (EPCRA).
- This regulation affects Risk Management Plan (RMP) facilities and their engagement with LEPCs relating to discussion and operations based exercises and information sharing.
- The regulatory sections of concern are §§68.67 – 68.175.
- A recommendation was made to explore options of updating the TCLEPC website for facilities to share a calendar or be able to list planned exercise activities in Tulsa County.

**Presentation**

**DEQ Tier II Presentation**

- Tom Bergman with ODEQ presented an overview of the Oklahoma EPCRA
- Also presented were updates to CAMEO/MARPLOT
  - New map data is available for pipelines, earthquake activity and casino locations.
  - Data is also available for 10 years of historical incidents for Oklahoma Highway Patrol hazmat responses and reportable pipeline releases.
- 2016 Tier II reporting process has not changed from previous years
- Oklahoma oil and gas facilities changing ownership should contact ODEQ to streamline the transfer of existing Tier II data
- EPA Region VI LEPC workshops are anticipated to be held in July or August 2017 at various locations throughout Oklahoma.
